Tipper Turning Heads

DJ & A Contractors recently purchased a Hardox steel tipper from Hamelex White that is already exceeding all expectations.

Based in Melbourne's Thomastown, demolition specialist DJ & A Contractors is currently working in the towns that were ravaged by the Black Saturday bushfires in February, making good use of a new tipper from Hamelex White that is hard at work clearing steel, concrete and dirt, among other things.

This specially designed tipper has been receiving a great deal of attention wherever it goes thanks to its black and chrome finish.

"The trailer looks very nice, painted black and finished off with 10 stud chrome wheels. It's a pretty nice set up – in fact, it looks absolutely magic – and it's turning heads wherever it goes. I couldn't be happier with it," says Dave Saddler from DJ and A Contractors.

Constructed of high tensile Hardox steel plate, this 30' tipper is designed to withstand the huge impact caused by heavy falling objects. Hardox steel is renowned for its strength, with a weight closer to that of aluminium, and Hamelex White has used Hardox right throughout the tipper – including in the floor, walls and tailgate.

Competition for building the new DJ and A Contractors trailer was stiff, but Hamelex White won out in the end, with its strong reputation for quality proving to be the decisive factor.

"I hadn't used Hamelex before but chose them because I liked the look of their trailers, how well they are designed and the reasonable price. So far, our new trailer has done all and more that's been asked of it," says Dave.

"It's a versatile trailer, really. You can get your cubic rate high on it, too – up to 29 cubic metres – which is important when you're doing demolition work. It also has higher five foot sides, allowing you to get more weight in there as well."

Such is the impact of the eye-catching finish that several operators have stopped Dave out on the road, to find out more about the trailer. In fact, a friend of Dave's has just put a deposit on a similar unit, while another operator is also set to send through an order.

"They see the trailer and are pretty impressed with it. I tell them that the trailer is great and dealing with Hamelex White was excellent."
